1. Any hackney carriage used to undertake a private hire booking under this operator's licence must be one that is licensed by this authority pursuant to section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847

2. Any hackney carriage used to undertake a private hire booking under this operator's licence must be driven by a person holding a licence issued by this authority pursuant to section 46 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847

3. The records required to be kept by the operator under section 56(2) of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 must be kept in a suitable book, the pages of which are numbered consecutively, or other durable recording format and the operator shall enter or cause to be entered therein **before** the commencement of each journey, the following particulars of every booking of a private hire vehicle invited or accepted by him, including where a booking is sub-contracted (whether the vehicle that is used is licensed under section 48 of the 1976 Act, or is licensed as a hackney carriage under section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847):

- a. The time and date of the hiring
- b. The name of the hirer
- c. The agreed time of the pick-up
- d. The point of pick-up
- e. The destination
- f. The proprietor, registration number, licence number and call sign of the vehicle allocated for the booking
- g. The name and licence number of the driver
- h. Remarks (including details of any sub-contract)

4. The operator shall also keep records of the particulars of all vehicles operated or used by him (whether licensed under section 48 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 or under section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, which particulars shall include details of the proprietors, registration numbers, licence number and drivers of such vehicles, together with any radio call sign used.

5. The operator shall keep records of all desk clerks employed by him, including their name, date of birth and home address. A daily record must be kept of the time worked by each clerk.
